## Lungu releases undisclosed huge amount of money to embattled Litunga Lubosi—in his desperation to halt the actualization of Barotseland statehood

The embattled Litunga Lubosi lacks both the legitimacy and authority to call for such a meeting. The People have since demanded his abdication. We alert the People of Barotseland to carefully monitor and record these developments.
